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Success at City Council for Two CAIP Members

CAIP is thrilled to announce that the first two members who have expressed interest in building a secondary suite have crossed the first hurdle, which is a land use re-designation approved by City Council.

The process started in April with CAIP making an application on behalf of a member in Ogden and a member in Fairview whose lots are currently not zoned for suites. The Co-operative prepared the application on behalf of the members, made the submission to the City's planning department, and followed the application through Calgary Planning Commission to City Council. The Chair of the CAIP board also spoke on behalf of the applications at City Council on September 12th with both receiving approval.

With a positive outcome at City Council, these members are now able to make a decision about how they want to proceed; whether that be with a secondary suite, garden suite, carriage house (above garage suite), or simply not take action at all at this time.
